
Dear Chairman Boehner:

Thank you for including SHRM in the hearings before the Subcommittee on Employer/Employee Relations of the Committee on the Education and the Workforce of the United States House of Representatives.

I request that the official record be changed regarding page 2, paragraph 2 of my statement to reflect the fact that Member Brame's term expired on August 27th, instead of August 31st of 2000. Second, on page 34, paragraph 2 of my testimony, I cite the fact that the Board's case log is approximately 883 cases. I have been informed by the Executive Secretary of the Board that the pending case number at present now is approximately 590. Accordingly, the sentence in question should now read, "Today the Board's case backlog is approximately 590 cases, according to information provided to me by the NLRB's Executive Secretary."
