“(B) shall cooperate in the Secretary’s efforts under section 1308 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6398) to ensure the linkage of records pertaining to migratory children with a disability for the purpose of electronically exchanging, among the States, health and educational information regarding such children; and

3           “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of  
4 the United States shall conduct a study on how lim-  
5 ited English proficient students are being served  
6 under this Act.  
7           “(2) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the  
8 date of the enactment of the Improving Education  
9 Results for Children With Disabilities Act of 2003,  
10 the Comptroller General of the United States shall  
11 submit a report containing the findings from the  
12 study conducted under paragraph (1) to the Com-  
13 mittee on Education and the Workforce of the  
14 House of Representatives and the Committee on  
15 Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Sen-  
16 ate.
