

Page 120, strike lines 7 through 22 and insert the following:

1 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall, for
 2 students enrolled full time in a baccalaureate or
 3 associate’s degree program of study at an eligi-
 4 ble institution, award such students two Pell
 5 grants during a single award year to permit
 6 such students to accelerate progress toward
 7 their degree objectives by enrolling in academic
 8 programs for 12 months rather than 9 months.

9 (B) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall
 10 limit the awarding of additional Pell grants
 11 under this paragraph in a single award year to
 12 students attending—

13 (i) baccalaureate degree granting in-
 14 stitutions that have a graduation rate as
 15 reported by the Integrated Postsecondary
 16 Education Data System for the 4 pre-



1 ceding academic years of at least 30 per-
2 cent; or

3 (ii) two-year institutions that have a
4 graduation rate in the Integrated Postsec-
5 ondary Education Data Systems, in at
6 least one of the last three years for which
7 data is available, that is above the average
8 for the applicable year for the institution's
9 type and control.
